Goals:

- 5. Parents with limited English proficiency will have information provided to them in a language and format that they understand.
- 6. Timely responses to parent questions, concerns, and recommendations will be made.

- 8. Conferences will be scheduled each semester and may be requested by the parents to discuss their child's progress at any time. Parents are strongly encouraged to participate in the decision-making process about the education of their child.
- 9. Individual student assessment results, including an interpretation of such results, will be shared at conferences or through mailed communications. Parents will also receive an explanation of the state standards for their child's grade and the assessment used by the district to measure student progress towards those standards.
- 10. A spring survey will provide parents with an opportunity to make requests for additional meetings and/or activities and to assess the effectiveness of the current parent involvement activities.
